TO CITY CLERK FOR PLACEMENT ON NEXT
REGULAR COUNCIL AGENDA TO BE POSTED

On Wednesday, August 6, 2025, the County of Los Angeles will host the City Clerk Summit and the We Speak Your Language events at the Japanese American National Museum. The City Clerk Summit will bring together city clerk personnel from across Los Angeles County to collaborate on best practices and new developments in the field, while the We Speak Your Language event will recognize the critical importance of continuing to provide election materials in multiple languages.


There is a City-owned parking lot located at 414 E. Temple Street that can be used to accommodate parking for 150 event participants. To cover the waiver of the parking fees, it is estimated that \$2,025 in costs will be incurred by the Special Parking Revenue Fund. Once the final amount is determined, it will be reimbursed by Council District 14.

I THEREFORE MOVE that Council AUTHORIZE the Department of Transportation (LADOT) to:

1. Suspend enforcement of parking from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday, August 6, 2025 at Lot 753 (414 E. Temple Street) to provide parking for 150 attendees for the City Clerk Summit and the We Speak Your Language: 50 Years of Language Access and Empowerment event at the Japanese American National Museum.
2. Accept funding from the Council District 14 portion of Council Fund No. 100-28, Account No. 006010 (Office and Administrative) to reimburse the Special Parking Revenue Fund for costs associated with the suspension of parking enforcement on Wednesday, August 6, 2025 at Lot 753 (414 E. Temple Street) to provide parking for the City Clerk Summit and the Speak Your Language: 50 Years of Language Access and Empowerment event.
3. Prepare Controller instructions to make any necessary technical corrections consistent with this action, subject to approval of the City Administrative Officer.

I FURTHER MOVE that should the date of the event change due to unforeseen circumstances, the aforementioned departmental instructions will apply.
