Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Hutt – Lee):

REQUEST the City Attorney, with the assistance of the Bureau of Sanitation and the Bureau of Street Services, to report with recommended changes to the Los Angeles Municipal Code to clarify City agency responsibilities of enforcement of trash bins left within the public right-of-way outside of allowable hours and options for enhanced enforcement to ensure that sidewalks and streets remain accessible to all residents.

## SUMMARY

At the meeting held on September 2, 2025, your Energy and Environment Committee considered a Motion (Hutt – Lee) relative to clarifying City agency responsibilities of enforcement of trash bins left within the public right-of-way outside of allowable hours and options for enhanced enforcement to ensure that sidewalks and streets remain accessible to all residents.
