

MOTION

I MOVE that the matter of the ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND JOBS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to grocery transparency laws in other jurisdictions, best practices, and identifying policy recommendations for the implementation of a similar policy in Los Angeles; and requesting City Attorney to draft an Ordinance that would require grocery stores that offer digital-only discounts to make readily-available physical coupons with identical pricing available to consumers, Item No. 3 on today's Council agenda (C.F. 25-0893), BE AMENDED to change Recommendation No. 2, as follows (as indicated in bold and underline):

- 2. REQUEST the City Attorney, with the assistance of the relevant City departments, to prepare and present an ordinance that would require grocery stores that offer digital-only discounts in-store to make a readily-available ~~physical~~ coupons in-store alternative with identical pricing available to consumers modeled after the City of San Diego's current ordinance.
