Comments for Public Posting: I respectfully but firmly oppose Councilmember Imelda Padilla's motion to move forward with the Sun Valley Metrolink Station Tiny Homes Project. This proposal would eliminate critical commuter parking, placing a severe burden on residents who depend on public transportation for work, school, and daily responsibilities. Reducing parking access will discourage Metrolink ridership, increase traffic in surrounding neighborhoods, and harm local businesses. As a lifelong resident of this city, I know how essential reliable transit is to our community. Converting the Metrolink parking lot into a tiny home site will make commuting more difficult, forcing more cars onto already congested streets. While addressing the unhoused is a priority, it should not come at the expense of the transportation infrastructure that thousands of residents rely on every single day.
