

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to implementing wider bike lanes to accommodate police and fire vehicles.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Hutt – McOsker):

INSTRUCT the Departments of Transportation and City Planning, in coordination with Bureau of Street Services and the Bureau of Engineering, to report on options and recommendations that would require bike lanes to provide sufficient width for emergency vehicle access.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On September 10, 2025, your Transportation Committee considered an August 13, 2025 Motion (Hutt – McOsker) relative to implementing wider bike lanes to accommodate police and fire vehicles.
