Comments for Public Posting: Criminals use malicious QR codes to steal money and data by redirecting users to phishing websites that collect personal and financial information or download malware onto devices. This attack method is often called "quishing," a combination of QR code and phishing. Scammers place fraudulent QR code stickers over legitimate ones in high-traffic areas like parking meters.
