Panorama City is home to one of the many Filipino American communities that can be found throughout the City of Los Angeles.


A strong network of Filipino organizations supports the community in Panorama, including the Pilipino Worker Center, which opened its first community hub in the valley in 2025.

The core value of Filipino psychology is *Kapwa*, which means “to see oneself in the other and to recognize our shared identity.” This understanding of interconnectedness fosters a deep sense of community and shared humanity among Filipinos in the San Fernando Valley.

As a tribute to the Filipino community in Panorama City, the corner of Roscoe and Woodman should be renamed “Kapwa” Square in honor of fundamental Filipino values behind the continued prosperity of the community.




