CIVIL RIGHTS, EQUITY, IMMIGRATION AGING AND DISABILITY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing an intake system to collect personal testimony from impacted individuals or witnesses of federal immigration enforcement actions in the City, to potentially be used in court actions in response to violations of civil and constitutional rights and temporary restraining orders.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Rodriguez - McOsker, Jurado):

INSTRUCT the Civil + Human Rights and Equity Department, in consultation with the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), with the assistance of the City Attorney, the Community Investment for Families Department, and Information Technology Agency to report to Council in 30 days on the feasibility of establishing an online intake system to collect personal testimony, written or recorded, from impacted individuals or witnesses of federal immigration enforcement actions in the City, to potentially be used in court actions in response to violations of civil and constitutional rights and temporary restraining orders.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on September 19, 2025, your Civil Rights, Equity, Immigration, Aging and Disability Committee considered a Motion (Nazarian - McOsker, Jurado) relative to establishing an intake system to collect personal testimony from impacted individuals or witnesses of federal immigration enforcement actions in the City, to potentially be used in court actions in response to violations of civil and constitutional rights and temporary restraining orders.

After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation, as amended, as stated above. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
