On behalf of our membership, I'm urging you to support the maximum indoor temperature ordinance. Extreme heat is the deadliest weather threat we face, and as our climate warms, more days each year will expose residents to dangerous, even life-threatening conditions inside their own homes. South LA residents are especially vulnerable. Decades of disinvestment and redlining have left our communities in older, poorly insulated buildings, facing high energy costs, and too often without access to indoor air conditioning. This puts families at serious risk of heat-related illness. Adequate cooling should be a basic habitability requirement in every home, just as heating already is. This is not about comfort; it is about health, safety, and dignity. We urge you to vote yes on Agenda Item #3.
