

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT and BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEES' REPORT relative to a grant agreement from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for a Brownfields Community-Wide Assessment (CWA) Grant.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Director, Bureau of Sanitation, and General Manager, Bureau of Sanitation, to negotiate, accept, execute, and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests etc., subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form, which may be necessary to secure grant funds from the EPA for a CWA Grant.
2. ADOPT the accompanying Resolution for authorizing acceptance of the USEPA CWA Grant.
