

PUBLIC WORKS and TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEES' JOINT REPORT relative to streamlining permitting for work in the public right-of-way associated with national and international events hosted in the City.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez – Hernandez):

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Street Services, with the assistance of the Bureau of Engineering and the Department of Transportation, to report with recommendations to streamline permitting for work in the public right-of-way associated with national and international events hosted in the City.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On October 22, 2025, your Transportation Committee and Public Works Committee considered a September 10, 2025 Motion (Rodriguez – Hernandez) relative to streamlining permitting for work in the public right-of-way associated with national and international events hosted in the City. According to the Motion, the City will host the FIFA World Cup, the Super Bowl, the NBA All-Star Game, the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games, and many other high-profile gatherings. To avoid unnecessary delays and ensure City readiness, it is critical that permitting processes be reviewed and streamlined for work tied to major events. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committees moved to recommend approval of the Motion recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
