

MOTION

The alley south of W. 62nd Street and north of W. Gage Avenue between Figueroa Street and Flower Street has become a public nuisance. Residents in the area surrounding the alley have reported multiple incidents of illegal dumping and criminal activity, including illegal drug use, prostitution, and violent assaults, occurring at this alley.

Pursuant to State Vehicle Code Section 21101.4, the City is authorized to undertake the temporary closure of public streets for a period of eighteen months when necessary to mitigate criminal activity and/or illegal dumping.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Engineer be instructed to report with recommendations to temporarily close the alley south of W. 62nd Street and north of W. Gage Avenue between Figueroa Street and Flower Street, pursuant to State Vehicle Code Section 21101.4, with the southern portion of the alley to remain open to ensure all adjacent properties remain accessible.
