

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTIONS relative to State and Federal advocacy for homelessness funding and prompt dispersal.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying Resolutions to:

- 1. Include in the City’s 2025-26 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT for administrative and/or legislative action to maintain two-year funding allocations and categories, consistent with the 2024 Continuum of Care Program application and award.
- 2. Include in the City’s 2025-26 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for administrative and/or legislative action to expeditiously release Homeless Housing Assistance and Prevention (HHAP) Round 6 grant funds, to fund HHAP Round 7 consistent with previous program years, and to distribute HHAP grants in full.
