## RE: ACCEPTANCE OF BEQUEST FROM THE GRAY FAMILY TRUST

Recommendation for Council Action, subject to the approval of the Mayor:

- ACCEPT a \$46,800 bequest from the Gray Family Trust on behalf of the City of Los Angeles Department of Animal Services, West Valley Animal Services Center;
- **2. APPROVE** the deposit of these funds into the Animal Welfare Trust Fund Fund No. 859, Account 060002 W. Valley Shelter;
- 3. APPROVE the disbursement of these funds restricted for the purpose of the bequest; and,
- **4. FORWARD** the acceptance of this bequest to the Mayor and City Council for approval.

## **SUMMARY:**

On April 9, 2025, the Department received notification from the Hornstein Law Offices, informing the Department that it would be the recipient of a bequest from the Gray Family Trust to be used for the West Valley Animal Services Center. On September 3, 2025, the Department received a check in the amount of \$46,800 from the Gray Family Trust.
