

WASHINGTON — The Federal Aviation Administration announced Friday that it would reduce air traffic by 10% across high-volume markets Friday morning to

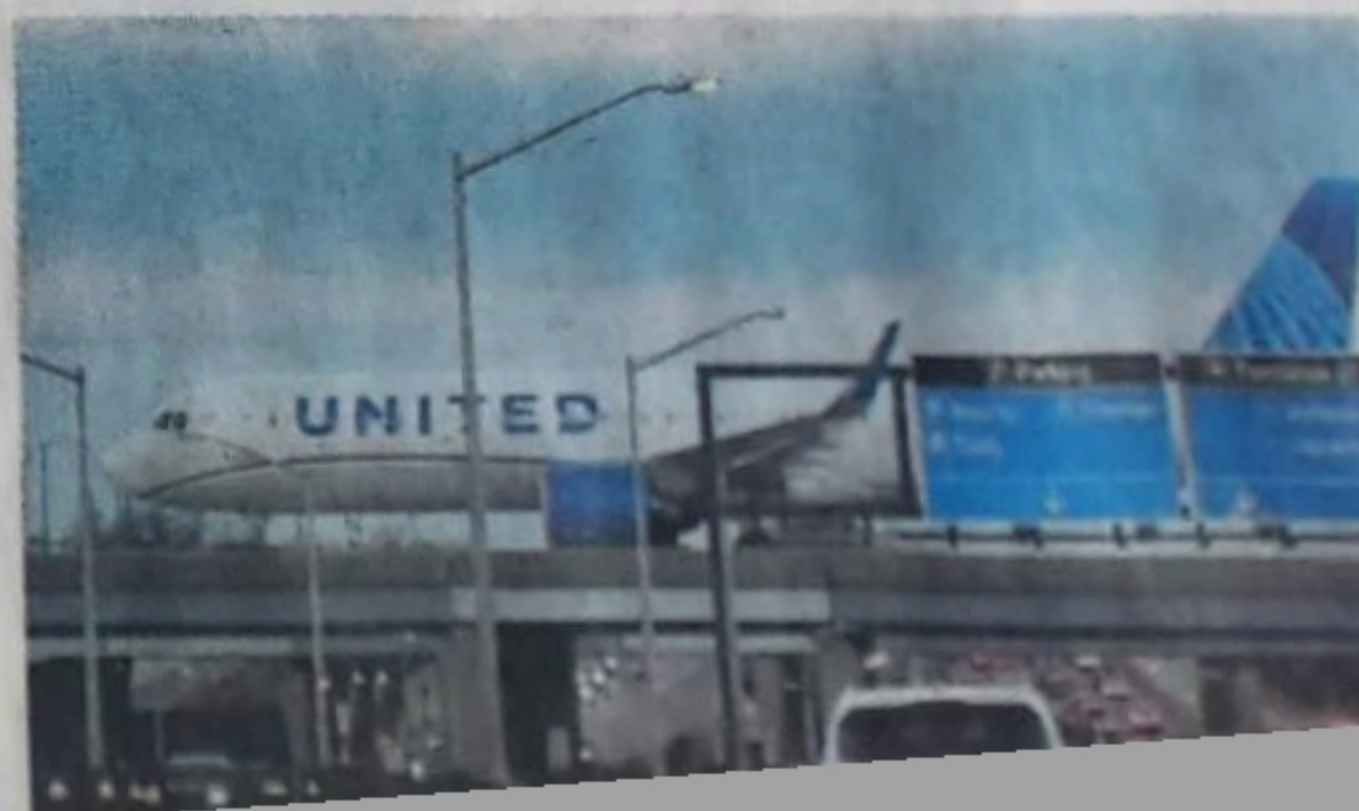
