## CIVIL RIGHTS, EQUITY, IMMIGRATION, AGING AND DISABILITY

## **MOTION**

The City's 47th Program Year (PY 47) Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan (Con Plan) provided Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding for the North Hollywood Sun Valley Area 1 Street Lighting project (later renamed the North Hollywood-Morella Street Lighting project). The intent of the project was for the Bureau of Street Lighting (BSL) to design and construct 58 new street lights in a residential area of Sun Valley (C.F. 20-1433).

On January 20, 2023, in accordance with State Proposition 218, the City Clerk certified voter approval of an assessment related to maintenance costs for the North Hollywood-Morella Avenue CDBG Street Lighting District (C.F. 22-0900-S65). However, the CDBG funds allocated to the project were subsequently reprogrammed. As a result, BSL was unable to move forward with construction of the project, even though the design and balloting was complete.

The City's PY 48 Con Plan provided CDBG funding for the Sidewalk Improvements and ADA Ramps in CD6 project, which involved the construction of sidewalks and access ramps within eligible areas of Council District 6 (C.F. 21-1186-S1). This project was recently completed, and the remaining CDBG funds have been identified to support completion of the North Hollywood-Morella Street Lighting project.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$493,000 be transferred / appropriated from the Community Development Trust Fund No. 424, Account No. 21W556 (Sidewalk Improvements and ADA Ramps in CD 6), to the Community Development Trust Fund No. 424, Account No. 43VB18 (N Hollywood Sun Valley CD6 Area 1) for construction of street lights in the North Hollywood-Morella Street Lighting District.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Community Investment for Families Department (CIFD) be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications, or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, and including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections / clarifications / changes may be made orally, electronically or by any other means.

I FURTHER MOVE that the CIFD be instructed and authorized to prepare, process, and execute the necessary documents with and/or payments to the Bureau of Street Lighting, or any other agency or organization, utilizing the above amount, for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
