INSTRUCT the DAS, with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), to report to Council on the costs needed to invest in large transport vehicles and personnel, including potential funding sources, to expand the DAS' ability to host and participate in more Pet Fair events throughout the City, including potential participation in community resource fairs, health fairs, and other City-sponsored events.
