**I MOVE** that the matter of the PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the feasibility of requiring City Council consideration for First Amendment permits for special events with costs to the City of Los Angeles exceeding \$100,000, **Item 17** on today's Council Agenda (CF 25-1268), **BE AMENDED** to **ADOPT** the following **ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDATION**:

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Street Services and the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to report on the departmental costs incurred per First Amendment gathering and parade over the past 5 years. The report should include the location, time, number of attendees, and duration of street closures for each event. The report should include, but not be limited to, recurring events such as the Blessing of the Animals at El Pueblo, May Day demonstrations, and Nisei Week in Little Tokyo.
