

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the feasibility of requiring City Council consideration for First Amendment permits for special events with costs to the City of Los Angeles exceeding \$100,000.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. NOTE and FILE the Board of Police Commissioners report dated February 3, 2026, relative to Special Events Permits.
2. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Police Department to report back on First Amendment parades that incur costs of less than \$100,000 for potential cost recovery.
3. REQUEST the City Attorney, in coordination with the Los Angeles Police Department, to report back on recommended amendments to Los Angeles Municipal Code Sections 41.20, 41.20.1, and 103.111 to strengthen the City’s cost recovery strategies.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None reported by the Board of Police Commissioners (BOPC). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
