I do not think that property owners that defraud our city departments should be allowed to do so in that the owner did not reveal to planning that they would be cutting off access that has previously existed. The access to the parks and bike paths that take the public to the coast are extremely important to me and my fellow residents of Venice and Del Rey Neighborhoods. When a property owner benefits from the parks as this owner one does (residents of our building use the park and our units are much more valuable as a result and we pay this owner for services), then they also must be bound by the regulations determined by elected representatives. I have lived in Azzurra, which also has a back entrance, but since the county has been putting pressure on my building management to close this entrance, I am aware that my access may be completely cut off if both the back door of my building AND the Ralph's parking lot are challenged. It is my understanding that this wall was not built or initiated by Ralph's, and Ralph's has supposedly stated that they do not perceive a problem of theft caused by the previous access. I am at a loss as to why this wall was built and why there was no prior public hearing on this. I sit on the Land Use and Planning committee of Venice Neighborhood District, within which this wall sits, and this was not given to our committee to be heard by planning, which is required, I believe. Without prior public hearing, or a hearing by the coastal commission, a permit was issued that severely impacts the safety of the public. People who previously accessed the bike path must now travel very dangerous and busy roads (Lincoln) to reach it. I hate to think what would happen to the city if a child was injured or killed while riding their bike to access the bike path on Lincoln Blvd. Thanks for revoking the permit. Sarah.
