On my way home I decided to wait a while, watching what others might do. Within 15 min of observation, I saw around 7 different people forced to scale the wall somehow. One person had to lift their dog over. Some had to lift their bikes. A jogger had a new obstacle in their routine — it was clear this wall came with no warning. I've lived here over a decade and the path was always there, though I always wondered if it would ever be properly paved. Instead, this? Everyone was disappointed, or annoyed, or frustrated. I remember seeing evidence part of the wall was knocked down in protest (though repaired), and small stacks of blocks placed to help one scale over, and I felt like someone cared, in that act. This community cares about being able to actually walk this beautiful place (or ride, run, whatever else) and that's been massively hindered. The "alternative" path is straight up worse; I would never send my elderly mother that way, having tried it myself. We're cut off from the library, my pharmacy, The Boardwalk, and of course the park itself — that's right behind our home! This wall is selfish, full stop, and needs to come down for our collective good.
