WHEREAS, in December 2022, Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) joined City of Los Angeles Contract ARC 40 220000000019 (City Contract) with MX Solutions and established Outline Agreement 4600006455 for a three (3)-year term, expiring on December 19, 2025, and for amount of \$450,000. Said Outline Agreement allows LAWA to purchase the parts necessary to maintain its elevators, HVAC (heating, ventilation, and air conditioning) systems, automatic sliding doors, sewage pumps, and other related systems. It was amended in March 2025 to increase the amount to \$900,000; and

WHEREAS, the City Contract expires on August 31, 2026 and provides two (2) additional one-year renewals that will potentially extend its term to August 31, 2028. LAWA's Outline Agreement will include those renewal options as well and extend the term accordingly; and

WHEREAS, the City Contract meets LAWA's standards for maintaining the above-mentioned systems. Joining the City Contract, instead of conducting a separate competitive bid, streamlines procurement by leveraging competitively solicited agreements that comply with local and state requirements, saving time and reducing administrative burden; and

WHEREAS, funds for the Outline Agreement are available in the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 LAWA Operating Budget in LAX Cost Center 1150068 – Mechanical Repair Shop, Commitment Item 522 – Materials and Supplies. Funding for subsequent years will be requested as part of the annual budget process; and

WHEREAS, although no inclusivity goals were set by either the City or LAWA, MX Solutions is certified with the City as a Small Business Enterprise and Women-Owned Business Enterprise located in Commerce, CA; and

WHEREAS, actions taken on this item by the Board of Airport Commissioners will become final pursuant to the provisions of Los Angeles City Charter Section 373;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Airport Commissioners adopted the staff report; further adopted staff's determination that the requested action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article II, Section 2.f of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines; found that the requested action is exempt from the competitive bid process requirements per Los Angeles City Charter Section 371(e)(8) and Administrative Code Section 10.15(a)(8) in that it is for a contract for a cooperative arrangement with another government agency for utilization of a purchasing contract of that agency; approved the Second Amendment to Outline Agreement 4600006455 with JRLR Enterprises Inc. dba MX Solutions to add \$450,000 in contract authority, for new total not to exceed \$1,350,000, and extend the term through August 31, 2028 covering supply and delivery of bearings, belts, and oil seals for Los Angeles World Airports; and authorized the Chief Executive Officer, or designee, to execute said Second Amendment to



Outline Agreement 4600006455 with JRLR Enterprises Inc. dba MX Solutions subject to approval by the Los Angeles City Council and approval as to form by the City Attorney.
