

ADMINISTRATIVE EXEMPTION and TRADE, TRAVEL AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to BOAC Resolution No. 28250 and proposed First Amendments to Contract DA-5590 with Atkinson Andelson Loya Ruud & Romo and Contract DA-5591 with Liebert Cassidy Whitmore.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. CONCUR with the determination by the Board of Airport Commissioners (BOAC) that this action is administratively exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article II, Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. APPROVE Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) Board Resolution No. 28250, authorizing First Amendments to Contract DA-5590 with Atkinson Andelson Loya Ruud & Romo and Contract DA-5591 with Liebert Cassidy Whitmore to extend their respective terms by two (2) years, and add \$200,000 in contract authority to Contract DA-5590, covering legal advice and related services for Los Angeles World Airports.
3. AUTHORIZE the LAWA Chief Executive Officer, or designee, to execute said First Amendments to Contract DA-5590 with Atkinson Andelson Loya Ruud & Romo and Contract DA-5591 with Liebert Cassidy Whitmore.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The BOAC reports that approval of these amendments will not impact the City's General Fund. Funding for these contracts is available in the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Los Angeles World Airports Operating Budget in Cost Center 1110004 – Legal Services, Commitment Item 520 – Contractual Services. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
