Dear Councilmembers,

As a CD11 resident, I am writing to urge the LA City Council reject LADWP's Scattergood EIR and grant the appeal. The EIR does not meet the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). This project is dangerous, expensive, polluting, and communities don't want it.

The money spent on this project prolongs reliance on fossil fuels, rather than investing in truly clean, non-combustion technologies that will help LA meet its 2035 clean energy goals. LADWP adopted a very narrow project description that unfairly favors combustion generation, even while those same goals could be met through non-combustion alternatives.

PLEASE REJECT this EIR, and prioritize environmental justice, climate, and public health by pursuing cleaner alternatives.
