

MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations in order to effect settlement in the case entitled TRISTAR Risk Management v. City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 23STCV22639. [The litigation arises from a contract that TRISTAR Risk Management (Tristar) had with the City to provide workers’ compensation administration services for the City’s sworn police officers, Contract No. C-121812.], **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney’s Office to expend up to **\$225,000** in settlement of the above-entitled matter, to be paid to Tristar out of the funds previously encumbered under Contract No. 121812 by the Personnel Department, which is less than 15 percent of the damages originally demanded by Tristar; and, less than the \$286,000 in liability exposure estimated by the City Attorney’s Office. The settlement does not require any payments from the General Fund and uses monies already earmarked for Tristar.

2. AUTHORIZE the Personnel Department to initiate an Electronic Funds Transfer payment to Tristar for \$225,000.

This matter was recommended for approval by the Budget and Finance Committee (Yaroslavsky – Blumenfield – Hutt – McOsker – Hernandez: “Yes”) at its meeting held on December 2, 2025, in Closed Session as permitted by Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1).
