

MOTION

Council District 12 sits at the frontline of Los Angeles' wildfire risk, with large portions of the northwest San Fernando Valley designated as Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zones. These hillside and wildland-urban interface communities face increasing threats as hotter, drier conditions, longer fire seasons and erratic fire behavior.

Preparing our neighborhoods through vegetation management, defensible space compliance, hardening homes, and ensuring rapid evacuation readiness is not just prudent, it is essential to protecting lives, property, and the unique character of our communities. As these risks continue to grow, so must our commitment to comprehensive wildfire preparedness across CD12.

MySafe:LA is a non-profit organization that delivers fire prevention and disaster readiness programming to communities across Los Angeles, fostering more resilient communities. MySafe: LA is a formal partner of the Los Angeles Fire Department and has expressed a desire to partner with Council District 12 on a Wildfire Resource and Education Fair.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council RESOLVE that \$14,250 in the Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund No. 699-14 be allocated to MySafe: LA to develop and procure essential supplies for a Council District 12 Wildfire Resource and Education Fair.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be instructed and authorized to prepare, process and execute the necessary documents with and/or payments to MySafe: LA, or any other agency or organization, as appropriate, utilizing the above amount, for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.


