Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Raman – Soto-Martinez):

INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP), to report to Council on an ongoing funding source for daily security services at Runyon Canyon Park from 7:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

**SUMMARY**

At its meeting held on February 3, 2026, your Budget and Finance Committee considered Motion (Raman – Soto-Martinez), dated December 12, 2025, relative to instructing the CAO, with the assistance of the RAP, to report on an ongoing funding source for security services at Runyon Canyon Park from 7:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m., to ensure the continued enforcement of its closure after Sunset as mandated by the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC). The LAMC designates Runyon Canyon Park as a park located in a Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone, and is in close proximity to densely populated areas. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee recommended that Council approve the recommendation contained in the Motion, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
