SUMMARY:

The City of Los Angeles Harbor Department (Harbor Department) is requesting approval of the First Amendment to Agreement No. 20-3764 and Consent to Assignment and Assumption from Saab Technologies Ltd. (Saab) to Tidalis Americas Ltd. (Tidalis). The requested First Amendment would allow a one-time transfer to reflect the vendor's name change due to Saab being acquired by Agilitas 2020 Private Equity GP Sarl which is now Tidalis. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged.

The Harbor Department will continue to be financially responsible for the payment of expenses incurred under the Agreement.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board):

1. Find that the Director of Environmental Management has determined that the proposed action is administratively exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Article II Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines;
2. Approve the First Amendment to Agreement No. 20-3764 with Saab Technologies Ltd. to allow a one-time assignment to Tidalis Americas Ltd., effective March 31, 2023;
3. Approve the Assignment and Assumption of Agreement No. 20-3764 and Consent Thereto, effective March 31, 2023;

DISCUSSION:

Background and Context – Agreement No. 20-3764 (“Agreement”), which the Board approved at its July 23, 2020 meeting and the City Council approved at its December 9, 2020 meeting, is for software license and maintenance fee to use the Saab software, and professional technical support services for the Harbor Department Billing, Port Pilot and Property Management Systems. These services are needed to continue to use these systems and to improve their capabilities to support current and future operations. Services include software development due to tariff changes, reports, integrations with other systems, and future enhancements and requirements from the Wharfinger, Port Pilots, Waterfront-Commercial Real Estate, and Information Technology Divisions. The Agreement has a not-to-exceed compensation amount of \$3,000,000 and a term of five (5) years ending on December 16, 2025.

On March 31, 2023, Saab was acquired by Agilitas 2020 Private Equity GP Sarl and changed its name to Tidalis Americas Ltd. The proposed First Amendment (Transmittal 1) will amend Section 12(B) of the Agreement to allow for this one-time assignment of the Agreement to Tidalis. The Assignment and Assumption Agreement is attached as Transmittal 2. Tidalis has confirmed that the services and personnel fulfilling the Agreement has not changed and will continue without gaps or compromise in quality. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged.

ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The proposed action is the approval of the First Amendment to Agreement No. 20-3764 to change the vendor’s name from Saab to Tidalis, which is an administrative activity. Therefore, the Director of Environmental Management has determined that the proposed action is administratively exempt from the requirements of CEQA in accordance with Article II, Section 2 (f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Approval of the proposed Amendment will assign Agreement No. 20-3764 to Tidalis following its acquisition of Saab. Staff does not anticipate a financial impact to arise if the proposed Amendment is approved because key personnel who have been fulfilling the Agreement since its



2. Adopt the December 7, 2023 Board of Harbor Commissioners findings that the proposed action is administratively exempt from the requirements of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Article II Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines; and
3. Authorize the Port Executive Director, or designee, to execute the proposed agreement, already approved as to form by the City Attorney, and return the Resolution to Port for further processing, including Council consideration.

SUMMARY

The Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board) requested approval of the December 7, 2023 Resolution No. 23-10289 (Attachment 1) which authorizes the proposed First Amendment to Agreement No. 20-3764 (Agreement) between the Los Angeles Harbor Department (Port) and Saab Technologies, Ltd. (Saab) to allow a one-time assignment to Tidalis Americas Ltd. (Tidalis). The approval of the Assignment and Assumption of Agreement No. 20-3764 and Consent Thereto (Assignment and Assumption) is retroactively effective March 31, 2023. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged, including the original contract expiration date of December 16, 2025.

The proposed amendment has been reviewed and approved as to form by the City Attorney. The

proposed amendment has been reviewed and approved as to form by the City Attorney. Pursuant to Charter Section 373 and Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 10.5, Council approval is required because the cumulative contract term exceeds three years. Our office has reviewed the request and recommends approval.

BACKGROUND

On March 31, 2023, Saab was acquired by Agilitas 2020 Private Equity GP Sarl and changed its name to Tidalis. Due to the acquisition, the proposed amendment is necessary to amend Section 12(B) of the Agreement to allow for this one-time assignment of the Agreement to Tidalis. Pursuant to the proposed Assignment and Assumption, Tidalis would assume all rights, obligations, and liabilities associated with the Agreement. Tidalis has confirmed that the services and personnel fulfilling of the Agreement has not changed and will continue without gaps or compromise in quality. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged.

Agreement No. 20-3764 with Saab – On July 23, 2020, the Board approved the sole-source Agreement with Saab, a Canadian corporation, for an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 and a term of five years from December 17, 2020 through December 16, 2025, to provide proprietary software licenses, maintenance, and professional technical support services for the Port's Billing, Port Pilot, and Property Management systems (C.F. 15-0779). Services include software development due to tariff changes, reports, integrations with other systems, and future enhancements and requirements from the Wharfinger, Port Pilots, Waterfront-Commercial Real Estate, and Information Technology Divisions.

CITY COMPLIANCE

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) – On December 7, 2023, the Board determined that the proposed action is administratively exempt from requirements of CEQA pursuant to Article II Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.

The City Attorney has reviewed and approved the proposed amendment as to form. Pursuant to Charter Section 373 and Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 10.5, Council approval is required because the cumulative contract term exceeds three years. Our office recommends approval.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

Approval of the proposed amendment would assign Agreement No. 20-3764 to Tidalis Americas Ltd. following its acquisition of Saab Technologies, Ltd., with all other contract terms and conditions remain unchanged. The Harbor Department does not anticipate a financial impact due to the amendment. The recommendations in this report and proposed actions comply with the Department's Financial Policies. There is no impact on the City's General Fund.

ASSIGNMENT AND ASSUMPTION
OF AGREEMENT NO. 20-3764
AND CONSENT THERETO

THIS ASSIGNMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF AGREEMENT NO. 20-3764 and CONSENT THERETO (hereinafter referred to as "Assignment") is entered into by, between and among the CITY OF LOS ANGELES, a municipal corporation ("City"), acting by and through its Board of Harbor Commissioners ("Board"), SAAB TECHNOLOGIES, LTD., a Canadian corporation ("SAAB" or "Assignor") and TIDALIS AMERICAS LTD., a Canadian corporation ("Tidalis" or "Assignee").

WHEREAS, in December 2020, City entered into Agreement No. 20-3764 ("Agreement") with SAAB for the purpose of providing Billing, Port Pilot, and Property Management Systems, attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, on March 31, 2023, SAAB was acquired by Agilitas 2020 Private Equity GP Sarl which then changed its name to Tidalis Americas Ltd.; and

WHEREAS, SAAB seeks to assign the Agreement to Tidalis, Tidalis seeks to assume all rights and responsibilities pursuant to the assignment, and the City agrees to such assignment and assumption;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Effective March 31, 2023, the Assignment and all rights, obligations, liabilities and provisions thereunder shall be subordinate to, and Assignee shall strictly comply with and not conflict with, all terms, covenants and conditions of the Agreement, or as hereinafter amended, which Assignor and Assignee agree that they have read. Assignee agrees to operate in accordance with and to assume all rights, obligations, operations, restrictions, limitations and liabilities associated with the Agreement.
2. Neither Assignor nor Assignee shall, by amendment or otherwise, alter the rights and obligations contained in the Agreement, approved by this Assignment, without the prior written consent of the City. Consent to one such change shall not be deemed to be consent to any subsequent change.
3. Assignee agrees to observe, obey and abide by the City of Los Angeles Charter and Administrative Code, and all applicable ordinances, rules and other regulations of the City.
4. Assignee shall not assign, sell, or otherwise transfer its interest in the Agreement as set forth in Section 12 of the Agreement.
5. Assignor shall remain liable in all respects for the performance of each of the terms, covenants, provisions, conditions and obligations of said Agreement and this Assignment.
6. Assignee shall provide City not less than sixty (60) days prior written notice of any merger of Assignee with or into any other entity or of any dissolution of Assignee.

7. The Agreement and this Assignment supersedes any and all agreements and understandings previously made between any of the parties hereto relating to the subject matter of the Agreement. The Agreement may only be modified, amended or altered in writing.

8. The Agreement and this Assignment shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit or detriment of Department, Assignor and Assignee, their respective successors, assigns and legal representatives.

9. The Agreement and this Assignment shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of California and venue shall lie in the appropriate U.S. Federal Court or California Superior Court located in Los Angeles County.

10. This Assignment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to constitute an original, but all of which, when taken together, shall constitute one instrument.

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
