

MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Linda Gonzalez v. City of Los Angeles, et al., Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 23VECV05189. (This matter arises from a vehicle versus vehicle incident on April 29, 2022, that occurred at the intersection of Califa Street and Canoga Avenue, in Woodland Hills.), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney’s Office to expend up to **\$100,000** in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
2. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw a demand from Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, as follows: Law Offices of Wabby & Wabby and Linda Gonzalez in the amount of **\$100,000**.
3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer; and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

This matter was recommended for approval by the Budget and Finance Committee (Yaroslavsky – Blumenfield – Hutt – McOsker – Hernandez: “Yes”) at a Special meeting held on December 9, 2025, in Closed Session as permitted by Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1).
