

MOTION

In 2024, Council District 11 established a Restroom Ambassador Program at two public restrooms on Ocean Front Walk in Venice. Historically, these restrooms were prone to lodging, encampments, vandalism and other public safety issues, which deterred families, local residents and visitors from using one of Los Angeles’ most magnificent parkspaces. In addition to managing restroom access, restroom ambassadors also connect homeless individuals to services and housing to prevent encampments from permanently returning to an area where they had once been commonplace. The program has resulted in a marked decrease in incidents and is in need of further funding to continue existing services while expanding its scope to additional restrooms along Ocean Front Walk.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$600,000 in General City Purposes Fund No. 100-56, Account No. 000625 (Additional Homeless Services - CD 11) and \$300,000 in the Council District 11 portion of the Council Projects line item in the General City Purposes Fund No. 100-56, Account No. 000A28 [TOTAL: \$900,000] be transferred / appropriated to the Board of Public Works Fund No. 100-74, Account No. 003040 (Contractual Services) for continued services provided by the Coalition for Responsible Community Development for the Vibrant Venice Initiative in Council District 11, including the expansion of the Restroom Ambassador Program.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Board of Public Works, be instructed and authorized to prepare, process and execute the necessary documents with and/or payments to the Coalition for Responsible Community Development, or any other agency or organization, as appropriate, utilizing the above amount, for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Public Works be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, and including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections / clarifications / changes may be made orally, electronically or by any other means.
