Honorable Members:

Pursuant to your request on January 21, 2026, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality, amending Chapter 14, Division 4 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) to authorize the receipt of nonelective employer contributions by the City of Los Angeles Deferred Compensation Plan (Plan).

The draft ordinance amends certain applicable provisions to Chapter 14, Division 4 of the LAAC to authorize and provide for the Plan to receive nonelective employer contributions, on behalf of City employees who are participants in the Plan (Employer Contributions). With this amendment, the Plan will be able to receive nonelective Employer Contributions on behalf of the contemplated employees of the Los Angeles Department of Water & Power, as provided in the City Administrative Officer Report dated December 15, 2025.


