NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Los Angeles City Council will conduct a Public Hearing relative to the City Council's intention to confirm, levy and collect annual assessments totaling \$25 million for Fiscal Year 2026-27 to acquire land and develop, improve, restore, and maintain parks and recreational facilities for the Proposition K: L.A. for Kids Program [City of Los Angeles Landscaping and Lighting District 96-1, formed pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (California Streets and Highways Code Sections 22500 – 22679)].

The Public Hearing and consideration of this matter will be held on **Tuesday, May 26, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, in the John Ferraro Council Chamber, Room 340, City Hall, 200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012.

This City Council meeting will be broadcast live on Cable Television Channel 35, on the internet at <https://clerk.lacity.org/calendar>, and on YouTube. If the live video or audio is unavailable via one of these channels, members of the public should try another channel. The City Council will take public comment from members of the public in-person only; there will be no public comment by teleconference.

Requests for reasonable modification or accommodation from individuals with disabilities, consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act can be made by contacting the City Clerk's Office at (213) 978-1133.

A copy of the proposed Ordinance ordering confirmation, levy and collection of the annual assessments and the related Assessment Report and Engineer's Report may be examined in the Office of the City Clerk, Room 395, City Hall, 200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, as well as online at www.lacouncilfile.com, in Council file No. **25-1533**.

All persons having any objections to the levy and collection of the assessments may appear before the City Council and offer public comment. Written protests may also be submitted to the Office of the City Clerk prior to the conclusion of the public hearing. Written protests by a property owner must contain a description sufficient to identify whether the property owned by that person is within the District.
