

ADMINISTRATIVE EXEMPTION and TRADE, TRAVEL AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to BOAC Resolution No. 28259 and proposed First Amendment to Contract DA-5602 with Amadeus Airport IT Americas Inc.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. CONCUR with the determination by the Board of Airport Commissioners (BOAC) that this action is administratively exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article II, Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. APPROVE Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) Board Resolution No. 28259 approving the First Amendment to Contract DA-5602 with Amadeus Airport IT Americas Inc., to extend the term through December 31, 2028, with two (2) one-year renewal options, and increase the contract authority by \$402,781, for new total not to exceed \$777,781, covering software license and maintenance support for the PropWorks revenue invoicing system of Los Angeles World Airports.
3. AUTHORIZE the LAWA Chief Executive Officer, or designee, to execute said First Amendment to Contract DA-5602 with Amadeus Airport IT Americas Inc.
