I'm also an active member and organizer with SFV Mutual Aid, where we provide a weekly meal distribution for our unhoused neighbors, along with other resources. I GREATLY oppose the proposed location additions to 41.18 (and the ordinance in it's entirety) brought by Adrin Nazarian. We need City Council and the larger Los Angeles government agencies to provide SUPPORT, not criminalize and displace our unhoused residents. Criminalization and displacement equals death. We cannot keep displacing, fining, and arresting people into housing. That is not a solution. I understand the severity of the issue and believe housing is a human right. Los Angeles leadership should be looking into solutions to provide PERMANENT housing. Temporary hotel keys in exchange for carceral rules and surveillance are inhumane and again, not a solution. I don't care about the aesthetics of homelessness, I care about the people experiencing it and making sure they are treated with dignity and respect. I urge City Council to do the same and reject the pressure from constituents that have lost their empathy and notion of collective care. Do not add more 41.18 locations. Abolish 41.18.
