

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position on Assembly Bill (AB) 1954 (Ward), to require authorization to list, advertise, promote, or sell local public agency golf course reservations.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Rodriguez – McOsker), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

RESOLVE to include in the City's 2025-26 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 1954 (Ward), which would prohibit an operator of a third-party golf reservation service platform from listing, advertising, promoting, or selling reservations for a golf course owned by a local public agency without a written authorization from the golf course operator.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

On April 17, 2026, your Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered an April 2, 2026 CLA report and a March 4, 2026 Resolution (Rodriguez – McOsker), relative to establishing the City's position on AB 1954 (Ward), to require authorization to list, advertise, promote, or sell local public agency golf course reservations. According to the Resolution, tee time brokers have become a significant issue throughout the state by booking tee times all at once and reselling and brokering them at inflated prices on a secondary market impeding equitable public access. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Resolution. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
