WHEREAS, Calvin Joe is retiring after 30 years of distinguished public service, with decades of dedication exemplifying excellence and a long outstanding record of achievements, having faithfully served the citizens of Los Angeles since 1996; and

WHEREAS, Calvin began his municipal career with the City in 1996 as a Lead Claims Workers' Compensation Analyst at the Personnel Department's Workers' Compensation Division, investigating chemical exposure claims at the LAPD's Northeast Police Station, and in 1999, he was promoted to Management Analyst in the Department of Public Works' Contract Administration Bureau, serving as a Labor Compliance Officer, investigating Prevailing Wage violations for construction workers on Citywide Public Works construction projects; and

WHEREAS, in 2000, while at the Office of Finance, Calvin served as the lead Management Analyst Coordinator on the Joint Labor Management Committee (JLMC) on Workers' Compensation and Safety, and also served as the lead Management Analyst/ Workers' Compensation Coordinator for the Owner Controlled Insurance Program (OCIP) for the Northeast Interceptor Sewer and East Central Interceptor Sewer (ECIS NEIS) underground Sewer Construction Projects, expanding the City's wastewater infrastructure, extending it through the existing busy parts of the City of Los Angeles using Tunnel Boring Machines (TBM); and

WHEREAS, in 2005, Calvin was promoted to Risk Manager I at the CAO, and served as the liaison Risk Manager to the Information Technology Agency, City View Channel 35, Office of Finance, LACERS, City Clerk & Cultural Affairs, Community Development, Environmental Affairs, El Pueblo, the Mayor's Citywide Volunteer Bureau and managed the City View Channel 35 Special Risk Insurance program, and upon his promotion to Risk Manager II in 2021, he served as the liaison Risk Manager to all Citywide Homeless Programs, the Economic Workforce Development Department, the Los Angeles Housing Department, as well as all Public Works bureaus; and

WHEREAS, Calvin Joe, having performed in an exemplary manner as a Risk Manager in the CAO for 21 years, his patience, intelligence, integrity, knowledge and mentorship has encouraged growth, collaboration and promoted camaraderie among Risk Management staff; and

WHEREAS, Calvin Joe, has been married to Mary for 41 years and is the proud father of Justin and Jacob, and grandfather of Jireh; and after 30 years of dedicated, diligent and distinguished service to the City of Los Angeles, has decided to embark on his next adventure in retirement from the City of Los Angeles:
