La Ciudad de Los Angeles ofrece una recompensa pagadera a la discreción del Concejo de la Ciudad a una o más personas por la suma o hasta una cantidad en conjunto de \$50,000 por información que conduzca a la identificación y detención de la persona o personas responsables por la MUERTE DE EDWIN MORA, en la ciudad de Los Angeles el jueves 27 de marzo de 2025, a las 3:30 p.m. aproximadamente, Edwin Mora estaba en un campamento para personas sin hogar en West 2nd Street cuando se vio involucrado en un altercado con un sospechoso desconocido, quien le disparó varias veces, causándole la muerte. Tras una investigación exhaustiva, se identificó a Isaac Alexander "Troubles" Davila Magaña como a persona que disparó a Mora. A pesar de que se ha dictado una orden de aprensión contra Dávila, los detectives no han logrado localizar al sospechoso y creen que una recompensa puede incentivar a los miembros del público a proporcionar información sobre el paradero de Dávila y su implicación en el tiroteo.
