

MOTION

The LA Clippers LLC (Clippers) plan to host the 2026 National Basketball Association (NBA) All-Star Game Event (All-Star Event) between February 13 and February 15, 2026 at the Intuit Dome located within the City of Inglewood. Additionally, the Clippers intend to host a NBA All-Star Fan Experience Event (Fan Event) between February 12 and February 15, 2026 at the Los Angeles Convention Center located within the City of Los Angeles. To advance safety and support the Fan Event, the Clippers and the City collaborate in planning security, transportation, and crowd management requirements.

As a special event, the Fan Event is subject to the Special Events Ordinance which requires the recovery of costs for City services from the event sponsor. The Ordinance also provides for the negotiations with major sports or entertainment venues in determining a payment. In support of the long-standing partnership between the City and Clippers, the Clippers desire to provide the City with reimbursement for all necessary supplemental services provided in connection with the Fan Event.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council instruct the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and Chief Legislative Analyst to negotiate a contract between the City and the Clippers to provide supplemental City services for the NBA All-Star Fan Experience Event, and that the Clippers pay for full reimbursement of all provided supplemental City services, in accordance with Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 41.20.1(c) Events at Major Sports and Entertainment Venues; and,

I FURTHER MOVE that the Council authorize the use of supplemental Police law enforcement services to support the Clippers during the NBA All-Star Fan Experience Event, with full reimbursement of Police law enforcement services, in accordance with California Government Code section 53069.8; and,

I FURTHER MOVE that Council authorize the CAO to execute and administer the contract between the City and Clippers for the above supplemental City services, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.
