

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to requesting a report on current cannabis enforcement practices and identifying additional staffing or resources needed to address illegal cannabis operations and strengthen the regulated market within the City.

Recommendation for Council action pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez - Hutt):

REQUEST the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and all other necessary City departments and agencies, to report on the Cannabis Support Unit’s current procedures and practices, including recommendations for any additional staffing and resources needed to improve cannabis enforcement within the City.
