

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to expanding the design scope of the Sepulveda Basin Pedestrian Safety and Access Improvements Project.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Padilla - Lee):

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Engineering and Department of Transportation, with the support of the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO), to report within 90 days with recommendations, phasing, and funding options to expand the design scope of the Sepulveda Basin Pedestrian Safety and Access Improvements Project to include the intersections along Victory Boulevard at Balboa Boulevard, Birmingham Way, Louise Avenue, and Encino Avenue that would not delay the core project delivery, and how the expanded project scope would support existing City mobility and access policies and goals.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted
