Motion (Jurado, Hernandez – Yaroslavsky)

REVISE:

Revise the first recommendation in the Motion, as follows with the change in bold. All other aspects of the moving clause remain unchanged:

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct the Los Angeles Housing Department (LAHD), in collaboration with the Chief Legislative Analyst, City Administrative Officer, and Office of Finance, to report within ~~60 days~~ **15 days** with a comprehensive analysis of Measure ULA revenues, expenditures, and programmatic outcomes from April 1, 2023 through January 31, 2026, and projected for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2025-2026 and Fiscal Year 2026-2027.

ADD:

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council instruct the Chief Legislative Analyst to compile and analyze independent studies that have been conducted on the impact of Measure United to House LA on housing production in the City, and to review any proposed or enacted changes to ordinances in other jurisdictions that are similar to Measure ULA, including, but not limited to, Proposition I in San Francisco and Measure RE in Culver City.
