

HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to identifying and aligning unique identifiers between the City and outside agencies to track City-funded homeless service programs.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Raman – Blumenfield):

1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Los Angeles Housing Department (LAHD); and, REQUEST the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) and the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA), with the support of HR&A Advisors, to align on a common set of unique identifiers for current programs, as well as protocols for generating and sharing unique identifiers for new City-funded programs and/or when the contracted provider changes for a site or program, within 30 days.
2. REQUEST that the adopted identifiers be included in all internal and public reporting that is provided at the program level within 45 days and moving forward.
3. REQUEST that the aforementioned agencies add fields to their data systems as necessary to facilitate this change and allow for regular program-level reporting within 30 days.
4. INSTRUCT the CAO and Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), with the support of the LAHD, LAHSA, HACLA, and HR&A Advisors, to collaborate with the County to access Measure A funds to expedite implementation of data system coordination across all agencies within the Homelessness Response System.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.
