

GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to acceptance of a donation by the Skatepark Project with an estimated value of \$70,000 for the development of the Skatepark Project at the West Los Angeles Municipal Complex.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Park – Padilla):

1. ACCEPT the donation by the Skatepark Project of labor, material and equipment for four skate obstacles, handrails, ledges, wedge spine, signage, and replicated courthouse monuments at the West Los Angeles Municipal Complex, with an estimated value of \$70,000, and to thank the donor on behalf of the City.
2. AUTHORIZE the Skatepark Project be to perform the improvements described above in Recommendation No. 1; and, REQUEST the City Attorney, with the assistance of the Bureau of Engineering (BOE) and the Department of General Services (GSD), to negotiate the necessary agreement(s) with the Skatepark Project in connection with this donation.
3. DIRECT the GSD to grant reasonable access to the Skatepark Project to enter the West Los Angeles Municipal Complex to perform the work.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On February 3, 2026, your Committee considered a Motion (Park – Padilla) relative to acceptance of a donation by the Skatepark Project with an estimated value of \$70,000 for the development of the Skatepark Project at the West Los Angeles Municipal Complex. According to the Motion, the Skatepark Project, a nonprofit organization, was founded by Tony Hawk in 2002 and is dedicated to increasing access to outdoor recreation and free play in underserved communities by creating safe and inclusive skateparks. The Skatepark Project has helped build nearly 700 skateparks across all 50 states, has provided thousands of kids with skating equipment, and has facilitated local contests in which kids have participated. The Skatepark Project would like to work with the City to develop temporary improvements at the West Los Angeles Municipal Complex (Complex) that would allow for skating to safely take place at this site.

Although the Complex is slated for redevelopment, the BOE would work with the Skatepark Project to deliver these temporary improvements in the interim. These proposed improvements include: four skate obstacles, handrails, ledges, wedge spine, signage, and replicated courthouse monuments. The Skatepark Project will oversee the design/building of these improvements and will work with professional builders to develop the improvements. Additionally, the Skateboard Project will pay for any costs associated

with the proposed improvements. The value of the donation is approximately \$70,000. Action is needed to accept this donation and to authorize the donor to perform the work. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Motion. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
