

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to designating the intersection of West 8th Street and Valencia Street in Westlake as "Francisco Morazan Central American Community Square."

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Hernandez – Jurado):

1. INSTRUCT the Department of Transportation (DOT) to fabricate and install a permanent ceremonial sign designating the intersection of West 8th Street and Valencia Street in Westlake as "Francisco Morazan Central American Community Square."
2. AUTHORIZE the DOT to make technical corrections or clarifications to effectuate the intent of this motion.
