

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to authorizing a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Facility Maintenance and Signposting Services.

Recommendation for Council action:

NOTE and FILE the Department of Transportation (DOT) report dated January 23, 2026, attached to the Council file, relative to authorizing the General Manager, DOT, to release a RFP for Facility Maintenance and Signposting Services for a contract term of five (5) years.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The DOT reports that there is no fiscal impact on the General Fund. Services provided for Transit Facilities are funded by Proposition A, Fund 385, Account 427 - Transit Facility Security and Maintenance. Transit Signage services are funded by Proposition A, Fund 385, Account 420 - Transit Store. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On February 25, 2026, your Transportation Committee considered a January 23, 2026 DOT report relative to authorizing a RFP for Facility Maintenance and Signposting Services. According to the report, the DOT needs to purchase and lease new facilities for bus charging, bus parking, and maintenance to meet the City's environmental sustainability goals and transition to a 100 percent zero-emission bus fleet. The DOT is issuing this RFP to obtain qualified and licensed proposers to manage and maintain DOT Transit facilities and Transit signage. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend the report be noted and filed. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
