

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the current graffiti abatement resources, contractor performance, repeatedly targeted locations, the development of a prioritization matrix, and related matters.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Hernandez – Jurado):

INSTRUCT the Office of Community Beautification to report on the current graffiti abatement resources, including the list of current graffiti abatement contractors; assessment of contractor performance; their geographic distribution and service coverage across the City; the crew size and staffing role; the number of service days provided per week; 311 request volume per Council District and repeatedly targeted locations; and the methodology used for prioritizing requests. The report should also provide recommendations to ensure resources are deployed based on demonstrated need and service demand, including the development of a prioritization matrix.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
