

MOTION

Deferred maintenance from decades of under-investment in the Bureau of Street Lighting (BSL) and a surge in copper wire theft across Los Angeles have increased average repair times for broken street lights to nearly a year. To address the ongoing public safety and accessibility concerns from these outages in our neighborhoods, additional resources for repairs need to be allocated to support BSL personnel to complete this work.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Director of Accounting, Board of Public Works, be authorized to transfer / appropriate \$185,000 from the Council District 4 portion of the General City Purposes Fund - Council Projects, Fund No. 100-56 Account No. 000A28 to the below listed Accounts and in the amounts specified in the Street Lighting Fund No. 100 84 for street lighting repairs in Council District 4:
