

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to existing research contracts and technology deployment plans incorporating Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) vehicles for the purposes of mapping and data collection to assist with proactive identification of bulky items and other City services.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez – Jurado):

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Engineering and BOS, with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), to report to Council with recommendations on how existing research contracts and technology deployment plans can incorporate BOS vehicles for the purposes of mapping for and data collection that can assist with proactive identification of bulky items, and other suggested City services that should be identified in the report.
