

AD HOC COMMITTEE ON FILM, ENTERTAINMENT, AND CREATIVE INDUSTRY  
REPORT relative to reporting by City entities in connection with film permitting.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Nazarian – Rodriguez):

1. INSTRUCT the Board of Public Works Film Liaison, Los Angeles Fire Department, Los Angeles Police Department, Los Angeles Department of Transportation, Department of Recreation and Parks, and any other relevant Departments that play a role in the City's film permitting process, to periodically make reports at the request of the Chair of the Ad Hoc Committee on Film, Entertainment, and Creative Industry.
2. REQUEST FilmLA to periodically make reports at the request of the Chair of the Ad Hoc Committee on Film, Entertainment, and Creative Industry.

Summary:

On September 9, 2026, your Committee considered a Motion (Nazarian – Rodriguez) relative to reporting by City entities in connection with film permitting.
