

BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to requiring companies or entities competing in a City Request for Proposals (RFP) process, or entering into a City contract, to disclose if they are a plaintiff in litigation against the City.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Harris-Dawson – Lee, et al.):

REQUEST the City Attorney to draft an ordinance requiring companies or entities that are competing in a City RFP process, or otherwise entering into a City contract, to disclose if they are a plaintiff in litigation against the City.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

**SUMMARY**

At its meeting held on March 3, 2026, your Budget and Finance Committee considered Motion (Harris-Dawson – Lee, et al.), dated February 17, 2026, relative to requiring companies competing in a City RFP process, or otherwise entering into a City contract, to disclose if they are a plaintiff in litigation with the City. The proposed disclosure requirement would be formally incorporated into the City’s contracting process for transparency and due diligence in the selection of vendors and contractors. Councilmember Yaroslavsky introduced a motion, seconded by Councilmembers McOsker and Blumenfield, to amend the moving clause requesting the City Attorney to draft an ordinance requiring companies or entities that are competing in a City RFP process, or otherwise entering into a City contract, to disclose if they are a plaintiff in litigation against the City.

After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion as amended, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
